You have opportunities to learn in a variety of settings, use community services, and participate in activities of choice. We offer one on one and group instruction to achieve goals, develop self confidence, and promote "community inclusion.

Supports Coordination

You develop meaningful goals for your Plan of Service and we assist by linking you to desired community supports.

Vocational Supports

You have opportunities to identify skills and preferences followed up with recommendations for further action.

Service Availability

We will do all we can to minimize any wait time for our services. Much can be accomplished by communicating through early contacts. Conditions that may affect our efforts include availability of transportation, coordination with other organizations who are providing you with services and openings for the supports and services you are requesting.

Cost of Services

Our experience shows that most everyone receiving services does so at no cost to themselves. Services are typically funded through Community Mental Health, Michigan Rehabilitation Services, and in some cases private insurance. We do have an Ability To Pay policy which will be reviewed with you upon entry and annually thereafter. An individual will not be denied services because of the inability or refusal of responsible parties to pay for the services.
