



SWINE FLU INFORMATION PREVENTATIVE MEASURES

April 29, 2009

Based on recommendations from the Wayne County Health Department and the Center for Disease Control, STEP will implement the following procedures which will apply to all persons served, staff, volunteers, visitors, and others.

If you exhibit cold or flu like symptoms that include fever, coughing and/or a sore throat you must consult your physician and stay home to limit contact with others.

While at STEP please wash your hands frequently and use a tissue to cover your mouth if you sneeze or cough. Alcohol-based hand cleaners can also be used.

All hard surfaces in each STEP location will be sanitized using the products maintenance has available. This will be done during the day while the building is occupied as well as the regular cleaning schedule until the alert is over!

All STEP vehicles will be sanitized using a spray disinfectant to cover hard surfaces handled by individuals riding in the vehicle.

It is important that hand washing or use of hand sanitizer be encouraged especially as we visit the community.

It is important to limit contact with persons who are ill. Community exposure will be limited if the activity involves individuals who are exhibiting cold or flu like symptoms.

All individuals participating in the program who are exhibiting symptoms are to be reported immediately to the Resource Center Director or his/her designee. The President/CEO will be kept informed of all possible cases and developments.
