### **Self Determination Takes Another Course at Services To Enhance Potential**

Courses that are part of the **University of Independence** curriculum will now be held on site at the Northwest Resource Center. This opportunity grew out of an overwhelming interest shown by persons attending the self awareness luncheons last fall conducted by Mr. Yuself Seegars, [Disability Network/Wayne County-Detroit](#), and planning by the STEP Focus Group.

The first course, ***Self Advocacy and Communication/Relationships***, will be held in the mornings twice weekly on Tuesday's and Wednesdays. There will be two classes with 10 persons each. A successful conclusion of these first two classes, lasting 6 - 8 weeks, will lead to more University of Independence coursed being offered with greater opportunities for individuals to become more self reliant and self efficient in leading a self determined life.
